- I have a daily practice of Bible reading and reflection.
- I experience a spiritual connection with God and others during the weekend worship gatherings.
- I trust God with my circumstances and do not allow them to dictate my mood.
- I attend weekly worship gatherings to celebrate what God is doing in my life and the lives of others.
